This is called a “Me Map”; is a simple conversation starter that helps get past surface-level, trivial questions... Just follow the steps below!

1. In the middle of the space below, write your name and circle it.
2. Then draw some “webs” out from your name and include some basic info, writing each in a circle of its own. Consider things like your age, gender, ethnicity, socio-economic status, family structure, religion, passions/hobbies, music interests, future goals, etc. Try to have 5-8 webs branching off. Be sure to have a mix of personal examples and broad ones as well.
3. Finally, thinking of a stereotype about one of your elements of identity, complete this sentence for ONE of your boxes. “I am _____, but I am NOT _____.”
 - a. Ex: “I am a sports fan, but I am NOT a dumb jock.”
 - b. Ex: “I am wealthy, but I am NOT greedy.”
 - c. Ex: “I am political, but I am NOT close-minded.”
