


- 1. Thank you for this opportunity to present to you tonight.
- 2. Quoting from James Lindsay, "Possibly the most important topic happening in education, at least if you care about the well-being, health and safety of children and the future of this country, is "Social-Emotional Learning (SEL)." Social Emotional Learning is the psychologizing of schooling, and, as one might expect, it comes in a variety of forms. The most contemporary and relevant form is the most Marxist form because the Marxist educators have completely hijacked any legitimacy the program ever had and turned it into a Maoist nightmare to ruin the children so they can achieve their revolution."





- 1. SEL is a funded un-mandate in Ohio. There is no state law and no federal law which require local school districts to implement social emotional learning. Local school district boards may think it is mandatory and local superintendents may lead the board to believe this and even have it included in their local district strategic plans. It is not mandatory. It is optional. Additionally, they are called standards which gives the impression of being something that is mandatory.
- 2. SEL was born out of the Strategic Plan for Education: 2019-2024
- 3. SEL is funded by the state budget, taxpayer dollars and state debt.
- 4. SEL is funded by grants from the U.S. Department of Education, taxpayer dollars and state debt.







What is CRT?

Definition (1)

- 1. Calling everything you want to control "racist" until it is fully under your control.
- 2. A Marxian conflict theory of race; i.e., Race Marxism
- 3. A belief that racism created by white people for their own benefit is the fundamental organizing principle of society.

New Discourses Commentary

Critical race Theory is a Critical Theory of race. It distinguishes itself explicitly from previous approaches to race and racism, such as the liberal ones characterizing the Civil Rights Movement of the 1960s (but not the Black Power movement—see also, black liberationism). For example, in the introduction to the textbook *Critical Race Theory: An Introduction*, critical race Theory is characterized explicitly in these terms:

The critical race theory (CRT) movement is a collection of activists and scholars engaged in studying and transforming the relationship among race, racism, and power. The movement considers many of the same issues that conventional civil rights and ethnic studies discourses take up but places them in a broader perspective that includes economics, history, setting, group and self-interest, and emotions and the unconscious. *Unlike traditional civil rights discourse, which* stresses incrementalism and step-by-step progress, critical race theory questions the very foundations of the liberal order, including equality theory, legal reasoning, Enlightenment rationalism, and neutral principles of constitutional law. (p. 3, emphasis added)

A few salient points stand out in this paragraph. First, critical race Theory is <u>centrally concerned with power</u>, which it holds in higher regard than truth (indeed, it holds the postmodernist position that claims to truth are assertions of power by specific means). Second, it distinguishes itself from "traditional" civil rights and instead <u>favors identity politics</u> (in the radical sense). Third, <u>it is not interested in progress but revolution</u>. Fourth, <u>it calls into question "the very foundations of the liberal order, including equality theory, legal reasoning, Enlightenment rationalism, and neutral principles of constitutional <u>law.</u>" That positions critical race Theory as explicitly <u>anti-Western</u> and, in the narrower context in which it arose and mostly applies, anti-American. Critical race Theory <u>favors equity over equality</u>, where equity specifically refers to a particular understanding of social equity theory and not a more generalist notion of fairness. Indeed, it explicitly characterizes the idea of (racial) equality as a kind of conspiracy theory that leads people, especially people of color (double especially BIPOC), to accept the status quo and their systemically oppressed state of affairs (see also, internalized dominance, internalized oppression, and internalized racism, i.e., false consciousness).</u>

- 4. It is probably most useful to understand postmodernism as a rejection of both modernism. The PMists reject authenticity, unifying narratives, universalism and progress, achieved primarily through scientific knowledge and technology.
- 5. Took self-consciousnes, nihilism to extremes. It is ultimately a form of cynicism. Reaction to a rejection of rise of representative democracy, age of science, supersedence of reason over superstition, and the establishment of individual liberties to live according to one's values.
- 6. It has evolved into new forms and gained increased influence over culture, activism, scholarship, especially in the humanities and social sciences.
- 7. Education colleges are ground zero. Now working through the STEM subjects on college campuses and K-12 to make them woke.




